



Code of Conduct

Respect for others

I agree to act with respect toward all those I encounter through Calgary Senior Men's Slo-pitch athletes, coaches, officials, other volunteers, media, friends, and spectators. This means I will refrain from comments or behaviours which are abusive, offensive, racist, sexist, or otherwise belittling or demeaning to others. I will not harass or tolerate harassment by others. I will respect others as persons and treat them with dignity. I will respect the privacy of others. I will not endanger the safety of others through my actions.

Respect for self

I will act with fairness and integrity while playing our sport. I will not use any intoxicating substances during the game. I am expected to be honest, sincere, and trustworthy.

Respect for sport

I will honour and respect the spirit and traditions of our sport. I will not impede the preparation for competition of other competitors or teammates. I will respect the decisions of umpires and officials.

Respect for Calgary Senior Men's Slo-pitch

I accept Calgary Senior Men's Slo-pitch rules, policies and procedures governing events and competitions. I will comply with the reasonable requests of officials of Calgary Senior Men's Slo-pitch. I accept that I am an ambassador for Senior Slo-pitch and Calgary Senior Men's Slo-pitch. I will refrain from any action which might bring the sport of slo-pitch or the Calgary Senior Men's Slo-pitch into disrepute.

I will not use the using Calgary Senior Men's Slo-pitch (CSMS) logo without written consent.

Respect for property

I will respect the property and livelihood of others, which means refraining from vandalism, theft, and other forms of mischief. I will abide by the City of Calgary's Bylaw relating to Public Behaviour.
